You may use this form to change where your ballot is sent for an election, change the political party primary ballot you receive for one election, change the political party primary ballot you receive for all primary elections or cancel your permanent absentee voter status. 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Privacy Act Notice: This form requires personal information. The last four (4) digits of your Social Security Number are required. Your application will be denied if you fail to provide the last four digits of your Social Security Number or if you fail to provide any other information required to determine your qualification to vote by mail. Federal law (the Privacy Act of 1974; the Help America Vote Act of 2002) and state law (Virginia Constitution, article II, § 2; § 24.2- 701, Code of Virginia; the Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act) authorize collecting this information and restrict its use to official purposes only.

Warning: Intentionally voting more than once in an election or making a materially false statement on this form constitutes the crime of election fraud. Intentionally voting more than once in an election is punishable under Virginia law as a Class 6 felony and is punishable by a term of imprisonment of up to five years, or confinement in jail for not more than 12 months, and/or a fine of not more than \$2,500. Making a materially false statement on this form is punishable under Virginia law as a Class 5 felony and is punishable by a term of imprisonment of up to ten years, confinement in jail for not more than 12 months, and/or a fine of not more than \$2,500.

Instructions

How do I submit this form?

You may mail, deliver or scan the signed form and email it to your **local voter registration office**. You can find the contact information for your local voter registration office through the Department of Elections' website, www.elections.virginia.gov/LocalGR

If you prefer to vote in person, this form is not needed.

General Information

You may make change(s) only if you have already selected the "Permanent Absentee Option" on the "Virginia Absentee Ballot Application Form."

Your local office must receive your application by mail, email, or fax by **5:00 pm on the eleventh (11th) day before the election**.

Ballots are available 45 days before an election. *(If you register to vote in person, you must wait five days before you can have your ballot mailed to you.)*

Your Personal Information (Section 1)

Provide your personal information.

Your Registration Address (Section 2)

Provide the address listed on your voter registration record. If you have a rural address or are homeless, please describe where you live.

I'd like to (Section 3)

You may make change(s) only if you have already selected the "Permanent Absentee Option" on the "Virginia Absentee Ballot Application Form."

You may select one or more changes for the following:

- Where your ballot is sent for a Primary, General, or Special election, or for both a Primary and the corresponding General Election;
- The political party primary ballot for one election; or
- The political party primary ballot you receive for all primary elections.
- Cancel your permanent absentee voter status

I want to change the address where my ballot is sent (Section 4a)

You'll fill out this section if you want to change the mailing address where your ballot will be sent. If this section is not completed, your ballot will be mailed to the address on your voter registration record. You will need to select the specific election(s) for the change and include the date for the election(s).

Ballot Mailing Address (Section 4b)

Only fill out this section if

- You want your ballot mailed to a different address than the one in your voter registration record.

Ballots cannot be forwarded or sent "in care of"/"to the attention of" another person.

I would like to change the ballot I receive for a Primary Election (Section 5)

Only fill out this section if

- You want to change the party primary ballot you receive or discontinue receiving a party primary ballot.

You will need to indicate if your request is applicable for the next primary election or for all primaries.

I would like to be removed from the Permanent Absentee Voter List (Section 6)

Only fill out this section if

- You want to be removed from the Permanent Absentee Voter List.

You will no longer receive ongoing absentee ballots for every election.
