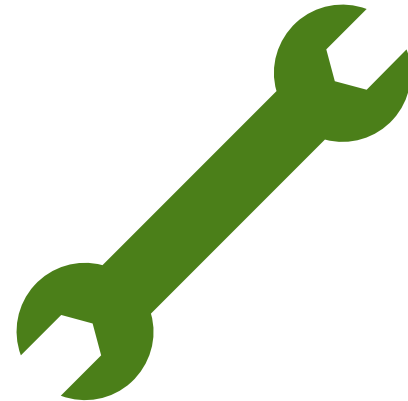

# Dual Party Primary

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- Open to all eligible voters
- Virginia does not register by party
- Voters must select ONE ballot
- The ballots contain different races

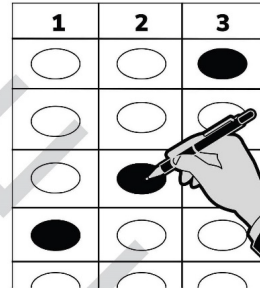
## Voting Instructions:

## Ranked Choice Voting Instructions

- Select your 1st choice by filling in the oval under the number 1 to the right of the candidate's name.
- To select a 2nd choice, fill in the oval under the number 2 to the right of the candidate's name.
- To select a 3rd choice, fill in the oval under the number 3 to the right of the candidate's name.
- Mark at least one candidate for your vote to count.
- If you make a mistake or need assistance, ask an election officer.

# Provisional Ballots

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- Any time a voter's eligibility can't be confirmed
- Any voter NOT registered in the pollbook AT YOUR PRECINCT must vote provisionally



A voter should never fill out  
both sides of the new  
Provisional Ballot Envelope.

# Example Provisional

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- Check voter's ID.
- Double-check voter's name in Pollpad
- Ensure the voter lives in your precinct.
- QR Code
- Street File



# **Check voter in on pollpad**

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# Paperwork Time

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- Add sticker to provisional envelope
- Give voter provisional envelope - line through other side
- Voter fills out Voter Registration Application on envelope
- Double check that ALL STARRED FIELDS are filled out correctly, especially section 3

# Paperwork Time

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- Registration Clerk completes their portion of the envelope.
- Voter collects ballot using Provisional Envelope and votes ballot
- When the voter returns, double check work
- Voter drops ballot in provisional bag
