Arlington County Electoral Board Meeting Minutes
February 10-13, 2026

The Electoral Board of Arlington County met in person at the Bozman Government Center, 2100 Clarendon Blvd., Room 318, on February 10, 2026 to conduct the canvass of the February 10, 2026 Special Election for the 39th Senate District. The meeting was called to order by Chair Kimberly Phillip at 7:00 pm. Also present were Vice Chair David Leichtman, Secretary Dominick Schirripa, General Registrar and Director of Elections Gretchen Reinemeyer, Deputy Director of Elections Alyssa Myers, and other members of the General Registrar's staff.

Results from precincts contained in the 39th District were reported to the office and were submitted to the state's results reporting system by 7:30 pm. The canvass was then adjourned until February 11, 2026.

The canvass resumed on February 11, 2026 at 8:00 am with preliminary evaluation of provision votes cast. The General Registrar and her staff, under the supervision of the Board, entered same-day registration provisional votes into VERIS and provisional ballot logs were produced.

The Board commenced the canvass of precinct results at 9:57 am and confirmed the accuracy of results as reported in the state results system.

At noon, the Board was available to hear from voters who had cast a provisional ballot and wished to speak in support of such ballots being counted. No voters presented to speak and so the Board did not resolve to go into closed session.

The canvass was recessed at approximately 1:00 pm. The General Registrar's staff continued the processing of same-day registrations as well as the processing of valid mail ballots received on February 11, 12, and 13, 2026.

The canvass resumed at approximately 2:00 pm on February 13, 2026. Ms. Phillip moved that the Board enter closed session pursuant to Va. Code § 2.2-3711 and § 24.2-653.01 for the purpose of considering the validity of provisional ballots cast at the February 10, 2026, Special Election. Ms. Reinemeyer was requested to attend to assist the Board in its determinations. Mr. Leichtman seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously. Thereupon, the Board resolved into closed session at 2:07 pm.

At 2:36 pm, Ms. Phillip moved that the Board resume its open session and certify that only the matters set forth in motion to enter closed session and that are properly the subject of closed deliberations under the Virginia Code were discussed. Mr. Leichtman seconded and the roll was called:

Chair Phillip – AYE
Vice Chair Leichtman – AYE

Secretary Schirripa – AYE

The motion passed and the Board resumed open session. Ms. Phillip reported that all 20 of the provisional ballots cast were accepted, broken down by precinct as follows:

- 1 ballot from Pct. 103
- 1 ballot from Pct. 106
- 4 ballots from Pct. 108
- 10 ballots from Pct. 121
- 2 ballots from Pct. 150
- 2 ballots from Pct. 153

Due to the number of ballots involved, the Board opted for a hand tally of the provisional votes and completed the required paperwork and canvassed the results.

The Board then proceeded to the canvass of the Central Absentee Precinct (CAP) and confirmed the results reported by the CAP election officers.

Ms. Reinemeyer was directed to prepare the abstracts of results for the Special Election for the signature of the Board.

There being no further business, Mr. Schirripa moved to adjourn. Ms. Phillip seconded. The motion passed unanimously and the canvass meeting adjourned at 3:27 pm on February 13, 2026.
