Arlington County Electoral Board Meeting Minutes
April 7, 2026

The Electoral Board of Arlington County met in person at the Bozman Government Center, 2100 Clarendon Blvd., Room 216, on April 7, 2026. The meeting was called to order by Chair Kimberly Phillip at 6:00 pm. Also present were Vice Chair David Leichtman, Secretary Dominick Schirripa, and General Registrar and Director of Elections Gretchen Reinemeyer.

Ms. Phillip moved that the agenda be amended to move the planned closed session earlier in the meeting to take place immediately following the public comment period. Mr. Leichtman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Schirripa moved that the minutes from the February 10-13, 2026, canvass meeting be adopted. Mr. Leichtman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Phillip moved that the minutes from the February 13, 2026, board meeting be adopted. Mr. Leichtman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment:

- Mr. Chris Wright spoke concerning any issue with registrations at an address in Arlington that is a commercial address and concerns with the response provided by the Registrar to inquiries he has made concerning this issue.
- Mr. Frank Lusby spoke to request that the Board, if possible, post in each precinct on Election Day, a poster containing the current congressional district maps alongside the proposed district map adopted by the General Assembly that would go into effect if the constitutional referendum is passed.

Ms. Phillip moved that the Board enter closed session pursuant to Va. Code § 2.2-3711(A)(19) and (34) and § 24.2-625.1 for the purpose of discussing our compliance with cybersecurity requirements imposed by ELECT. Mr. Schirripa seconded and moved an amendment that Ms. Reinemeyer and Richard Archambault, Chief of the Security, Privacy, and Records Division of the Arlington County Department of Technology Services join the closed session to aid the Board in its deliberations. Ms. Phillip accepted the amendment as a friendly amendment. The amended motion was approved unanimously, whereupon the Board resolved into closed session at 6:07 pm.

At 6:30 pm, Ms. Phillip moved that the Board resume its open session and certify that only the matters set forth in the motion to enter closed session and that are properly the subject of closed deliberations under the Virginia Code were discussed. Mr. Leichtman seconded and the roll was called:

Chair Phillip – AYE

Vice Chair Leichtman – AYE

Secretary Schirripa – AYE

Ms. Phillip moved that 43 individuals be appointed as officers of election for a term to commence immediately and expire February 28, 2029. Mr. Schirripa seconded. The motion was passed unanimously. The list of officers appointed is available for public inspection at the Office of the Registrar.

Ms. Reinemeyer reported that the Election Office staff is currently auditing candidate filings to identify campaigns that are delinquent or non-compliant with campaign finance requirements. With the expectation that campaigns identified by the audit will require disciplinary action, she requested that the Board include in future meetings a standing agenda item concerning such disciplinary actions.

Per the report of the Chair of the Arlington County Democratic Committee, there were three candidates who filed simultaneously to run in the party's primary for a seat on the County Board. Pursuant to Va. Code § 24.2-529, the Board drew lots to determine ballot order on the primary ballot. The candidates will be listed in the following order:

James DeVita
Matt de Ferranti
Julie Farnam

Ms. Reinemeyer provided an update concerning the early voting location and polling place at Madison Community Center, which will be relocated while the Center is being renovated. Early Voting will be held at the Langston-Brown Community Center. Election Day voting will move to St. Peter's Episcopal Church at 4250 N. Glebe Rd. Both changes will be effective for the August primary.

Ms. Phillip offered congratulations to Mr. Schirripa on his election as Treasurer of the Virginia Electoral Board Association at the annual meeting of the Association in March.

Ms. Phillip expressed a desire to communicate with the County Board and the School Board with the aim on establishing ongoing "board-to-board" meetings between members of each Board to facilitate the exchange of information between the three bodies. Ms. Phillip will draft the initial communications and will serve as the Board's representative to any such meetings established.

There being no further business before the Board, Mr. Schirripa moved to adjourn. Mr. Leichtman seconded. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:42 pm.
