**Arlington County Electoral Board Meeting Minutes**  
**May 12, 2026**

The Electoral Board of Arlington County met in person at the Bozman Government Center, 2100 Clarendon Blvd., Room 318, on May 12, 2026. The meeting was called to order by Chair Kimberly Phillip at 6:00 pm. Also present were Vice Chair David Leichtman, Secretary Dominick Schiripa, and General Registrar and Director of Elections Gretchen Reinemeyer.

Ms. Phillip moved that the minutes from the April 7, 2026, meeting and the April 21-25, 2026, canvass meeting be adopted. Mr. Leichtman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**Public Comment:**

- Mr. Frank Lusby inquired concerning non-citizens being removed from the voter rolls and information received from the state.

Ms. Phillip moved that 26 individuals be appointed as officers of election for a term to commence immediately and expire February 28, 2029. Mr. Leichtman seconded. The motion was passed unanimously. The list of officers appointed is available for public inspection at the Office of the Registrar.

There will be a dual primary on August 4, 2026. The Democratic Party will have a primary for the County Board and there will likely be a primary for U.S. Representative from the 8<sup>th</sup> District. The Republican Party will have a primary for U.S. Senate.

- Early voting will begin on June 18, 2026. Early voting will be closed on June 19 and July 3, 2026 in observance of federal holidays.
- The satellite locations (Walter Reed Community Center and Langston-Brown Community Center) will open on July 19 (Sunday), July 25 and 26 (Saturday and Sunday), and July 31 and August 1 (Friday and Saturday).
- Pre-processing will happen on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays between July 21 and July 31 between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm as needed.
- L&A testing on early voting equipment will be conducted beginning at 12:00 pm on June 9, 2026; testing on election day equipment will be conducted beginning at 9:00 am on July 9, 2026.
- The provisional ballot meeting will convene at 12:00 pm on August 5, 2026, and will reconvene on August 8, 2026, at 10:00 am.
- Canvass will begin on 9:00 am on August 5, 2026 and will reconvene at 5:00 pm on August 7, 2026, and at 6:00 pm on August 10, 2026.

Ms. Reinemeyer announced that the Office received two awards from the U.S. Election Assistance Commission: one for our hologram-style Halloween "I Voted" sticker and one for our streamlined results reporting system. In addition we received an honorable mention for our centralized "single-entry" canvass system.

There being no further business before the Board, Mr. Schirripa moved to adjourn. Ms. Phillip seconded. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:39 pm.
