Arlington County Electoral Board Meeting Minutes
August 4-8, 2026

The Electoral Board of Arlington County met in person at the Bozman Government Center, 2100 Clarendon Blvd., Room 318, on August 4, 2026 to begin the conduct of the canvass of the August 4, 2026, Dual Primary Election. The meeting was called to order by Chair Kimberly Phillip at 7:08 pm. Also present were Vice Chair David Leichtman, Secretary Dominick Schirripa, General Registrar and Director of Elections Gretchen Reinemeyer, Deputy Director of Elections Alyssa Myers, and other members of the General Registrar's staff.

Results from precincts were reported to the office and were submitted to the state's results reporting system. After all Election Day results were reported to the state's system the meeting was recessed at 9:00 pm.

The canvass reconvened at 8:57 am on Wednesday, August 5, 2026. Results from precincts were reviewed and confirmed by staff under the supervision of the Board and the General Registrar. Staff also commenced the processing of same-day registrations and provisional ballots.

Ms. Phillip moved that the Board enter closed session pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-3711 and § 24.2-653.01 for the purpose of considering the validity of provisional ballots cast at the April 21 2026, Special Election. Ms. Reinemeyer and Bob Sislak (Democratic Party authorized representative) were to attend to assist the Board in its determinations. Mr. Schirripa seconded the motion and it passed unanimously with Mr. Leichtman absent. Thereupon, the Board resolved into closed session at 12:05 pm.

At 12:12 pm, Ms. Phillip moved that the Board resume its open session and certify that only the matters set forth in the motion to enter closed session and that are properly the subject of closed deliberations under the Virginia Code were discussed. Mr. Schirripa seconded and the roll was called:

Chair Phillip – AYE

Vice Chair Leichtman – Absent

Secretary Schirripa – AYE

The motion passed and the Board resumed open session. No voters sought to address the Board regarding their provisional vote.

The canvass recessed at 1:30 pm. The General Registrar's staff continued the processing of same-day registrations as well as the processing of valid mail ballots received after Election Day.

The canvass resumed on Saturday, August 8, 2026, at 9:55 am, with Mr. Leichtman again present.

Ms. Phillip moved that the Board enter closed session pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-3711 and § 24.2-653.01 for the purpose of considering the validity of provisional ballots cast at the August 4, 2026, Dual Party Primary. Ms. Reinemeyer, Ms. Meyers, and Donna Patterson of the elections office staff were requested to attend to assist the Board in its determinations. Mr. Leichtman seconded and the motion passed unanimously. Thereupon, the Board resolved into closed session at 10:03 am. An authorized representatives from the Democratic Party (Mr. Sislak) was also present.

At 12:10 pm, Ms. Phillip moved that the Board resume its open session and certify that only the matters set forth in the motion to enter closed session and that are properly the subject of closed deliberations under the Virginia Code were discussed. Mr. Leichtman seconded and the roll was called:

Chair Phillip – AYE

Vice Chair Leichtman – AYE

Secretary Schirripa – AYE

The motion passed and the Board resumed open session. The Board reported that 223 provisional ballots (208 Democrat and 15 Republican) were accepted and cast and 14 provisional ballots (including 5 mail ballots for which the voter did not provide valid ID by the statutory deadline) were rejected, broken down as set forth on the attached schedule.

The Board then canvassed the Central Absentee Precinct (CAP) and the provisional votes to confirm that results were properly reported to the state.

The Board agreed to sign the Abstracts of Votes at its regular meeting scheduled for August 11, 2026.

There being no further business, Ms Phillip moved to adjourn. Mr. Leichtman seconded. The motion passed unanimously and the canvass meeting adjourned at 12:13 pm on August 8, 2026.
