




Confirm Address / Inactive

The voter is marked as inactive and has **NOT** moved from the address listed in the pollbook.

Steps

- Voter must complete the Affirmation of Eligibility.
- You complete Section A and check Box A. Disregard Statement of Challenger.
- Voter completes and signs Section B.
- Place form in Maroon Bag 8.
- Check in voter on pollbook.
- Give voter ballot.



Absentee Issued

Does the voter have their ballot with them?





Absentee Issued

The voter is showing as an Absentee Ballot has been issued and has their ballot with them.

Steps

- Have voter write **SPOIL** on ballot.
- Collect ballot from voter.
- Verify that it is from the current election.
- Place ballot in Envelope 4.
- Make a mark on the Ballot Record Report / Mail Ballot Exchanged Box.
- Check voter in on pollbook.
- Give voter ballot.

Absentee Issued

The voter is showing as an Absentee Ballot has been issued and does NOT have their ballot with them.

Steps

- This voter must vote a Provisional Ballot Reason 4.
- Since we cannot confirm that the voter has not returned their ballot and that the ballot is not being counted by the central absentee precinct on election, this voter must vote a provisional ballot.
- At the conclusion of the election, if a mail ballot has not been returned and the voter meets all other eligibility requirements, this provisional ballot will be counted

Does the voter still live overseas?





Overseas

The voter is showing as living overseas and states that they still reside overseas.

Steps

- Check voter in on pollbook.
- Give voter regular ballot.



Overseas

The voter is showing as living overseas and states that they have returned from overseas.

Steps

• Voter should complete a Voter Registration Application so that the overseas flag can be removed from the record.


- Write OVERSEAS across the top of the application.
- Place form in Maroon Bag 8.
- Check in voter on pollbook.
- Give voter regular ballot.

Show ID / Verify ID

Does the voter an acceptable ID?







Show ID / Verify ID

The voter is showing with the status VERIFY ID and has an acceptable ID with them.

Steps

- Check voter in on pollbook.
- Give voter regular ballot.



Show ID / Verify ID

The voter is showing as VERIFY ID and does **NOT** have an acceptable ID with them.

Steps

- This voter must vote a Provisional Ballot Reason No ID.
- This voter registered to vote by mail, did not provide an ID with their registration, and this is their first time voting in a federal election in Virginia. As such, they are subject to ID requirements under the federal Help America Vote Act.
- They are not eligible to sign the ID Confirmation Sheet, and must cast a provisional ballot. They have until noon on Monday to provide an ID to the Office of Elections.

• Call 703-228-3456. We want to talk to the voter to confirm that we have correctly entered their information.







- Write "Name Change" or "Apt Update" across the top of the application if applicable.
- Place form in Maroon Bag 8.
- Check in voter on pollbook.
- Give voter ballot.



This voter is listed on the pollbook in your precinct, but they have moved within Arlington 4-1 years ago.

Voter can vote a regular ballot at your precinct after affirming their eligibility OR complete a Same Day Registration and Provisional ballot at their new precinct.

Start Over

Steps

- Voter should complete an Affirmation of Eligibility.
- Complete Section A and Check Box C.
- Voter Completes Section B.
- Place form in Maroon Bag 8.
- Check in voter on pollbook.
- Give voter ballot.

This voter no longer lives in Virginia.

Steps

Voter moved on or after Oct. 7th, 2024

• Voter completes Request to Cancel Voter Registration Form.

Start Ove

- Check in regularly on pollbook.
- Issue a Presidential Only ballot on Ballot Marker.

Voter moved before Oct. 7th, 2024

- The voter is not eligible to vote in Virginia.
- Offer a Provisional Ballot.

This voter is no longer eligible to vote in your precinct.

They can complete a Same Day Registration and Provisional Ballot at their new precinct.

Steps

 Complete the Election Day Referral Form indicating the address of the voter's precinct.

Start Over

• Send voter to correct precinct.

This voter has chosen to return to their old precinct where they are registered to cast a regular ballot.

Steps

 Complete the Election Day Referral Form indicating the address of the voter's precinct.


Start Over

• Send voter to correct precinct.

This voter is eligible to complete a Same Day Registration and cast a provisional ballot at your precinct.

They can also return to their old precinct where they are registered to vote a regular ballot after completing paperwork.






Same Day Registration

The vote must complete the Same Day Registration & Provisional Process.

Steps

- Confirm that voter currently lives in your precinct.
- Check ID
- Register in pollbook.
- Check in provisionally on pollbook.
- Draw a line through the side of the envelope the voter should not complete.
- Voter completes the Provisional Ballot Envelope.
- Give Ballot.
- Review Envelope for Completeness.
- Place in sealed Provisional Ballot Bag.
- Give voter sticker & Provisional Ballot Notice explaining rights.



Provisional Ballot

The vote must cast a Provisional Ballot.

Steps

- Confirm that voter currently lives in your precinct.
- Check ID
- Find voter in Pollbook & check in provisionally.
- Voter completes necessary paperwork, if applicable. Place in Maroon Bag 8.
- Voter completes the Provisional Ballot Envelope.
- Give Ballot & Mark Provisional Ballot Record Report.
- Review Envelope for Completeness.
- Place in sealed Provisional Ballot Bag.
- Give voter sticker & Provisional Ballot Notice explaining rights.

Not Listed on Pollbook

Tips

- Did the voter register or vote at this location before?
- If yes, check spelling.
- Search by address.
- Call the Office to expand the search. 703-228-3456
- Complete the Telephone Form to assist the office find the voter.
- If voter cannot be found, complete Same Day Registration steps.
