New and New-ish

Federal Only and President Only Ballots

- Federal Only: From flag in Pollbook
- President Only: From Moving Conditions
- Must be voted on Ballot Marking Device

Provisional

Provisional Ballots

- Separate, labeled provisional ballots
- Won't be read by scanner
- Track on Provisional Ballot Logs

Provisional Ballot Log is Digital in Pollbook

SDR (new to Arlington)

Add Voter to the pollbook

Check in provisionally

SDR (Move Within Arlington

Update address in pollbook

Check in provisionally

All other Provisionals

Override with password if needed

Check in provisionally

Election Night Provisional Numbers MUST BE CORRECT

Match provisional ballot usage **Provisional Ballot Record Report** throughout the day Match total number of provisional Provisional check-ins on Poll Pad ballot envelopes in 1A Match total number of SDRs for Voters added to Poll Pad voters who are NEW to Arlington


Provisional Ballot Record Report

- The main office needs some data Election Night
- Also tracks provisional ballot usage
- Must be checked against Provisional Ballot Envelopes at close


- You only work elections a few times a year!

1.) Gather Information

- Registration Clerk referral
- Look the voter up in the Poll Pad
- Ask clear, direct questions
- Don't assume the voter's level of knowledge

2.) Diagnose

- Not registered in pollbook
- Information change
- Flag in pollbook





Moving Conditions

Two Options

Same Day
Registration at the
Precinct where
they live now

Update registration and vote at their old precinct

VRA. Regular Ballot

4 Pieces of Information

1. Is the voter currently registered in your precinct?

- 2. WHERE the voter lives now
- 3. WHEN they moved



Paperwork then Vote

- AoE Affirmation of Eligibility
- VRA Voter Registration Application
- Apartment update form

Mail Ballots and Election Day Voting

If they brought the ballot...

- 1. Deface the ballot
- 2. Mark on Ballot Record Report
- 3. Check in and issue new ballot

If they didn't...

- 1. Check in PROVISIONALLY on pollbook
- 2. Issue provisional ballot

Refer to Another Precinct

- Put as much detail as possible on the referral
- Only refer a voter if they have NO ability to vote at your precinct or the voter decides to go



Provisional Ballots

Provisional Ballots

- Any time a voter's eligibility can't be confirmed
- Any voter NOT registered AT YOUR PRECINCT must vote provisionally
- Must be cast in the precinct where they <u>currently</u> live

A voter should never fill out both sides of the Provisional Ballot Envelope.

Example Provisional - SDR

- Check voter's ID.
- Double-check voter's name in Pollpad
- Ensure the voter lives in your precinct.
- QR Code
- Street File



Check voter in on pollpad

Paperwork Time

- Give voter provisional envelope line through other side
- Voter fills out Voter Registration Application on envelope
- Double check that ALL STARRED FIELDS are filled out correctly, especially section 3

Paperwork Time

- Registration Clerk completes their portion of the envelope.
- Voter collects ballot using Provisional Envelope and votes ballot
- When the voter returns, double check work
- Voter drops ballot in provisional bag
- Give voter Provisional Voter Notice
